ORDER

The Receiver has now filed his Final Status Report, [Doc. 141], and seeks an order that, among other things, (1) approves a final distribution to the investors (Investors) who were defrauded in the Mobile Billboards scheme, (2) approves the Receiver's accrued and estimated fees and expenses, (3) authorizes the Receiver to redirect unclaimed funds, (4) allows the Receiver to terminate the receivership once all funds have been distributed, and (5) relieves the Receiver and his agents and employees of liability against claims for actions taken in good faith.

In consultation with the Receiver, this Court has deemed it appropriate to afford the Investors an opportunity to lodge any objection they may have to this Court's approval of the Final Status Report. Accordingly, the Receiver is **DIRECTED**, no later than January 20, 2010, to send a post card with the following message to the Investors:

To Mobile Billboard Claimants:

Gregory Hays, the receiver appointed to recover funds for defrauded investors in Mobile Billboards and its related companies, has filed his Final Status Report along with a proposed order that would allow Mr. Hays to make a final payment to investors and close the books on the Mobile Billboards matter. 

The presiding Federal Judge in Atlanta has ordered that if you have an objection to the court's approval of the Final Status Report, you must send a letter detailing your objection(s), postmarked no later than March 1, 2010, to:

This Court will receive and review any objections that Investors may send. The Receiver need not respond to any objection unless ordered to do so by this Court. **IT IS SO ORDERED**, this 7th day of January, 2010.
