## **DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

Defendant International Estate Brokers, LLC d/b/a Watch Brokers and d/b/a webuywatches.com ("Watch Brokers") and Defendant Ronald L. Bergh, III ("Bergh" and, together with Watch Brokers, "Defendants") were served with the Summons and Complaint in this action on October 8, 2012 as evidenced by the Affidavits of Service filed with the Clerk and by the Uniform Superior Court Rule 15 Certificate provided to the Court. More than forty-five days have elapsed since the date of service, and Defendants have failed to file defensive pleadings or move to open the default. Accordingly, the Court enters a DEFAULT JUDGMENT on all issues of liability as if every item and paragraph of the Supplemental Verified Complaint and Petition for Appointment of Receiver and Injunctive Relief were supported by proper evidence.

The Court held a damages hearing on September 9, 2013. Based upon the evidence presented, the Court hereby enters Judgment against the Defendants, jointly and severally, in the amount of  $\frac{1,760,292}{2}$
