ORDER

Upon reviewing the notice of noncompliance [125] filed by Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”), showing Defendant Kowalewski’s probable violations of the Court’s August 31, 2011 order, the Court is satisfied that the SEC has made a sufficient showing to necessitate a hearing on this matter. Therefore, Kowalewski is hereby ORDERED to show cause, if there be any, to this Court at 2:00 p.m. on the 29th day of September, 2011, in Room 2106 of the United States Courthouse, Atlanta, Georgia, or as soon thereafter as can be heard, why this Court should not issue an order holding him in civil contempt.

At the show-cause hearing, Kowalewski will also be given an opportunity to formally respond to the SEC's motion for disgorgement and civil penalties [113]. All parties should be prepared to present evidence and argument regarding that motion.

It is further ORDERED that each party file a brief by September 27, 2011 at 5:00 p.m., summarizing the evidence they expect to present at the hearing and the issues to be decided by the Court.
