
DECLARATION OF TRACI KOWALEWSKI


3. On or about August 13, 2010, WBM Contracting was administratively dissolved by the North Carolina Secretary of State.

It is my understanding that all of the items on the list were sold with the exception of the following:

Child's dresser and end tables
some clothes, dishes, glasses, toys, etc.
some bookcases
some of my mother's belongings
lawn mower
tools
wheelbarrow
jewelry
some holiday décor
some computers/printers
file cabinet
child's mirror

As stated in my declaration, all the fixtures were in place upon my leaving the house on July 27th. The house was in decent condition. The following documents the condition of the appliances and fixtures.

Downstairs kitchen

Average GE appliances, easily replaced at a home store, not special order or special sizes. In good working condition. Stainless steel sink. Cork floor was buckling. Cabinetry had been worn, some hinges loose.

Upstairs kitchen

Viking appliances. All required a tremendous amount of upkeep and maintenance. The icemaker in the fridge/freezer never worked. The fridge seal was broken and had a huge hole in it from day one. (Finally replaced with SubZero.) The microwave door button worked very poorly, there were sometimes we couldn't get the door open at all. The dishwashers were never installed properly; they continuously came unbalanced and tipped forward, making them very difficult to load. The oven/stove had a grill top that was very difficult to clean and disgustingly stained. Burner parts needed to be replaced frequently, and the finish on them was matted. The stove knobs were at a dangerous location for small children. I would never buy Viking appliances after my experience with them. I *may* be able to dig up receipts for repairs. Cabinetry overly worn.

Lighting

Decent taste. Don't know what they were made of. Difficult to clean/dust. Missing many parts.

Sinks/tubs/showers

Don't know what they were made of, but whatever it was, it was not conducive to cleaning. There was a bright green and white crusty buildup on the fixtures that was impossible to remove with cleanser. Looked disgusting and was embarrassing. The master bathtub hot/cold handles continuously fell off, as did the guest bath handles.

The house was a bit grimmer than I care for it to be, however, I had not had time to clean it and had let my cleaning crew go months prior. My vacuum came to South Carolina with me.

In paragraph THREE (not 5, as you stated, typographical error forgiven) "I do not possess any personal property, other than certain items listed on schedule 1...and/or fixtures..." I believe to mean that other than what the Receiver has agreed for me to keep, there are no other real property or large personal items in my possession.

One list is titled "...Personal Property that was removed..." and another is a list of assets that were granted to me by the Receiver. If there are discrepancies in the lists, it is simply because in having to create them from memory, we unintentionally forgot an item or two. One list is part of my settlement, and the other is part of Stan's. The Receiver has agreed to both.

I note the following discrepancies:

The following were inadvertently left off my SCHEDULE 1:

- Washer/dryer
- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Ovens
- Dishwashers
- 40" Vizio TV

Clarifications should be made to the following:

- We kept part of my daughter's bedroom suite, which was actually mine as a child, so technically only 3 full child's bedroom suites were sold.
- 26" LG LCD television is repeated on my SCHEDULE 1 (typo)
- Argonaut Office furniture encompasses furniture sold and office supplies/equipment kept
- My mother's items should not be in the equation at all
- I believe that according to North Carolina state law, all appliances are considered personal property
- We kept my daughter's mirror

I possess no fixtures from the Henson Farms house.

I did not know of the condition of the home until I saw the email containing pictures that the Private Investigator took. It is my understanding that the missing cupboards and fixtures were not removed by my husband, but rather an unknown gentleman. My husband is not handy with tools, so I strongly believe this to be true. I have left it for my husband to deal with the issue, which he has done to the best of his ability.

It is my understanding that my brother and my in-laws were present at the "Estate Sales."
