**CONSENT ORDER ON THE CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE’S OBJECTION TO CLAIMS
FILED BY CREDITORS MARGARET AND ROBERT KNOX**

Upon application of the Parties, including the Chapter 11 Trustee and Creditors Margaret and Robert Knox, the Court enters the following Consent Order on the Chapter 11 Trustee’s objections to their claims (Doc. No. 656).

In case number 11-12255, The Money Tree, Inc., Creditor Robert Knox filed a proof of claim, Claim No. 8, in the amount of \$154,155.02 for principal and interest owed on five (5) Money Tree, Inc. debentures. His wife, Margaret Knox also filed a proof of claim, Claim No. 9, in the amount of \$96,696.18 for unpaid principal and interest owed on one (1) Money Tree, Inc. debenture. On November 27, 2012, the Chapter 11 Trustee filed his Omnibus Objection to Claims (Doc. No. 656), and objected to Claims 8 and 9 in The Money Tree, Inc., Case No. 11-12255, citing objection codes K and L. Creditors Margaret and Robert Knox have agreed to the disallowance of their Claims 8 and 9 in The Money Tree, Inc., Case No. 11-12255, with the understanding that their claims will be provided for as a part of Claim No. 266 or Claim No. 463 filed by the U.S. Bank, the Indenture Trustee. Based on information provided by the Chapter 11 Trustee, Robert Knox's pro rata share of the U.S. Bank claim will be based on a claim amount of \$154,155.02. Based on information provided by the Chapter 11 Trustee, Margaret Knox's pro rata share of the U.S. Bank claim will be based on a claim amount of \$96,696.18. Because Claims 8 and 9 filed on behalf of Robert and Margaret Knox are provided for by U.S. Bank Claims 266 or 463, the Court hereby ORDERS that they should be disallowed and expunged as duplicate claims.

In Case No. 11-12258, The Money Tree of Georgia, Inc., Robert W. Knox filed a proof of claim, Claim No. 13, in the amount of \$589.32, including principal and interest. Margaret Knox filed a proof of claim, Claim No. 14, in an amount of \$101,696.85 including principal and interest. In his Omnibus Objections to Claims, (Doc. No. 656), the Chapter 11 Trustee objected to Claims 13 and 14 in The Money Tree of Georgia, Inc., Case No. 11-12258, citing objection code L. The Parties agree that these claims will be allowed in their scheduled amount but they will be scheduled in the name of the IRA Custodian, First Trust Company of Onaga on behalf of

Robert and Margaret Knox. Accordingly, this Court hereby ORDERS that Claims 13 and 14 be allowed in their scheduled amount but scheduled in the name of the IRA Custodian, First Trust Company of Onaga on behalf of Robert and Margaret Knox
