**ORDER GRANTING THIRD INTERIM AND FINAL APPLICATION FOR  
ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES  
OF HAYS FINANCIAL CONSULTING, LLC, AS ACCOUNTANTS TO THE  
CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE**

Before the Court is the Third Interim and Final Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Hays Financial Consulting, LLC, as Accountants to the Chapter 11 Trustee [Docket No. 860] (the “Application”) filed on May 30, 2013.

The Court, having considered the relief requested in the Application, the presentation of counsel at the hearing, and it appearing that the fees and expenses sought

are for actual and necessary services rendered and expenses incurred by Hays Financial Consulting, LLC (“HFC”) on behalf of the Chapter 11 Trustee in these cases; and it further appearing that the Application conforms with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the local rules of practice of this Court, and applicable case law regarding allowance and payment of professional fees and expenses in bankruptcy cases, it is

**ORDERED** that the Application is **APPROVED and GRANTED** on the terms set forth herein, and it is **FURTHER ORDERED**, that pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331, HFC is awarded interim compensation in the amount of \$82,195.50 in professional fees and \$222.50 in expenses incurred relating to its duties as accountants to the Chapter 11 Trustee for the period January 1, 2013 through May 22, 2013; and it is

**FURTHER ORDERED**, that HFC is awarded final compensation in the amount of \$254,716.66 in professional fees and expenses incurred relating to its duties as accountants to the Chapter 11 Trustee for the period May 1, 2012 through May 22, 2013.
