ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION PURSUANT TO FED. R. BANKR. P. 2014(a) FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER UNDER SECTIONS 327(a) AND 328(a) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF INTERNATIONAL AVIATION MARKETING, INC. AS AIRCRAFT BROKER FOR THE CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE

AND

GRANTING MOTION FOR ORDER PURSUANT TO FED. R. BANKR. P. 6004(c) FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER UNDER SECTION 363(f) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE'S SALE OF AIRCRAFT FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL LIENS, CLAIMS, AND ENCUMBRANCES

S. Gregory Hays, the chapter 11 bankruptcy trustee (the "Trustee") appointed in the above captioned cases, filed an Application Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2014(a) for Entry of an Order Under Sections 327(a) and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing Employment and Retention of International Aviation Marketing, Inc. as Aircraft Broker for the Chapter 11 Trustee and a Motion for Order Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(c) for Entry of an Order Under

Section 363(f) of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing and Approving the Chapter 11 Trustee's Sale of Aircraft Free and Clear of All Liens, Claims, and Encumbrances [ECF Docket No. 373] (the "Aircraft Motion") in this case on June 4, 2012.

The Court scheduled a hearing on the Aircraft Motion for July 12, 2012. At the hearing, appearances were made by Britt B. Griggs on behalf of the Bankruptcy Administrator and by Bradley R. Hightower on behalf of the Trustee. No objections were made to the Aircraft Motion and the Bankruptcy Administrator recommended that the Court approve the employment of International Aviation Marketing, Inc. ("International Aviation") as the Trustee's aircraft broker.

Based upon the Court's review of the Aircraft Motion, the recommendation by the Bankruptcy Administrator, and the lack of any objections to the Aircraft Motion, the Court finds that the Aircraft Motion is due to be granted. Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the Aircraft Motion is GRANTED; that the employment of International Aviation as the Trustee's aircraft broker is APPROVED; and that the Trustee is AUTHORIZED to sell the 1975 Beechcraft B58 Baron N7262R SN: TH-579 airplane free and clear of liens to any third party buyer selected by the Trustee so long as the price paid by the buyer nets at least \$90,000.00 to the Debtors' estates and the Unsecured Creditors Committee approves the sale.
